Restriction of Hazardous Substances in Electronic Power Supplies and Control Cabinets
EU-Directive 2011/65/EU from June 8th, 2011 (RoHS II)

Dear Ladies and Gentlemen,

The European Union (EU) Directive 2011/65/EU on the Restriction of the Use of Certain Hazardous Substances in Electrical and Electronic Equipment (RoHS II), prohibits placing on the EU market new electrical and electronic equipment (EEE) defined in categories in Annex I of the directive, that contains more than a defined value per homogenous substance of the product from lead (0,1%), mercury (0,1%), hexavalent chromium (0,1%), polybrominated biphenyl (PBB) and polybrominated diphenyl ether (PBDE) flame retardants (0,1%) or cadmium (0,01%).

This product is not subject to EU Directive 2011/65/EU (RoHS II), because it does not fall into one of the categories of electrical and electronic equipment restricted by the Directive. Irrespective thereof does this product not contain any of the hazardous substances restricted by the Directive to more than the maximum concentration values tolerated in homogenous materials.

Time limitation for Exemptions

Electrical and electronic equipment that was outside the scope of Directive 2002/95/EC (first RoHS), but which would not comply with Directive 2011/65/EU (RoHS II) may nevertheless continue to be available to the market until 22 July 2019.

This applies to our electronic power supplies and control cabinets
